2019-2020 Service Learning Project

This year, our service project at Osborne will be focused on providing clean water to those in need. We have teamed up with CEED to install a well at a primary school located in Uganda, Africa. Rather than a one-day event at Osborne, this service-learning project will be broken up into three events taking place throughout the school year:

- October 8, 2019: Project Kick-off Introducing the Idea. On this first day, Osborne students will get a glimpse of the Ugandan childrens' daily routines of walking miles to access water. We will learn about culture, the impact of clean water on our health and wellness, and how we might help students half-way around the world.
- December 20, 2019: Connecting with Students in Uganda. Now that we know how we can help, the students will dive into hands-on activities to engage in serving one another. We are lining up videos to be shared, writing letters for pen pals in Uganda, creating friendship gifts and more!
- March TBD, 2020: Celebrating the Completion. We will celebrate the joys of serving others as we bring the service learning project to a close at Osborne's annual International Festival on March 27th. We plan to create fun ways to display things that we learned about Uganda and their culture and how we were able to help.
